STANDARD CLASS

Preferred and Regular Divisions of Excellent A & B, Open, and Novice A & B within jump heights being run together.

JUMPERS with WEAVES CLASS

Preferred and Regular Divisions of Excellent JWW A & B, Open, and Novice A & B within jump heights being run together.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

Eligibility: This trial is open to all dogs age of 15 months of age and over that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registrable breeds that have obtained AKC ILP/PAL numbers or an AKC Canine Partners Listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance

AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each jump height of each class and division. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs that receive a qualifying score. MACH rosette and bar will be offered to any dog/handler team that completes their title at these trials. New title ribbons will be offered to any dog/handler team that completes their title at these trials. No unclaimed awards or ribbons will be mailed.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION AND WARM UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without dogs, prior to the start of each class before or after the Judge's briefing. There will be no equipment familiarization for Novice. No excessive training or corrections on the grounds will be allowed.

A WARM UP jump area consisting of one regulation agility jump will be provided for all exhibitors. This is not to be used as for training.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE & MOTEL INFORMATION

This is MICHIGAN....Construction on many roads...please plan accordingly.

From I-94 (heading West): Take the Zeeb Road exit and head North. You will cross the Huron River and then some RR tracks. At the stop sign turn left onto Huron River Drive. You will pass Dexter-Huron Metropark on your left (see map above). Approximately 1.5 miles down the road you will make a right turn onto the cross drive connecting us to Joy Road. The building at the corner is the Dexter Research Center. There is also a sign for "Dexter Martial Arts". We are the large building up the drive.

From I-94 (heading East): Take the Baker Road exit and head North. Stay on Baker Rd. until it ends in downtown Dexter (see map above). Turn left onto Ann Arbor St. and take the immediate right onto Central St.. You have to go around 'Monument Park'. Stay on Central and cross the Huron River. There is a party store on the corner where Huron River Drive and Mast Road intersect. You can either turn onto Huron River Drive and take the second driveway on the left (Dexter Research Center) or you can turn right onto Joy Rd. and go approximately 1/4 mile until you see a sign for "Dexter Martial Arts". Turn right onto that drive and we are the building immediately on your right.

From US-23 (Heading South): Take the North Territorial Road exit and head West. Go approximately 5.5 miles West until you come to a 4-way stop. Turn left onto Mast road and go 3 miles until you come to Joy Rd. (speed limit will drop to 25 here). The Dexter party store is on the left. You can either go past the party store, turn onto Huron River Drive and take the second driveway on the left (Dexter Research Center) or you can turn before the party store, onto Joy Rd., and go approximately 1/4 mile until you see a sign for "Dexter Martial Arts". Turn right onto that drive and we are the building immediately on your right.

From US-23 (Heading North): Take M-14 West towards Ann Arbor. Take the "Miller Road" exit. At the end of the exit ramp go across Maple Rd and you will come to Miller Rd. Turn right onto Miller and head West to Zeeb Rd (second stop sign). Turn right onto Zeeb and the first stop is Huron River Drive. Turn left onto Huron River Drive and approximately 1.5 miles down the road you will make a right turn onto the cross drive connecting us to Joy Road. The building at the corner is the Dexter Research enter. There is also a sign for "Dexter Martial Arts". We are the large building up the drive.

ENTRY FEE & ENTRY INFORMATION

- \$18 per dog. \$18 second entry of same dog/same day.
This includes a \$3.50 recording fee for the first entry and \$3.00 recording fee for the second entry.
- **Make check payable to: AADTC and mail to the Trial Secretary**
- Opening Period Start Date is December 6, 2012 at 8:00 a.m.
Closing date: January 28, 2012 at 6 PM.
- Overnight entries will not be accepted unless left WITHOUT signature required. Entries received before the opening time and date **MUST** be returned to sender. Per AKC rules:
- Only 10 ENTRIES maximum per envelope. Envelopes containing more than 10 entries maximum will be declared invalid and returned to sender. Entries will be opened prior to the draw and check for accuracy. All duplicate entries for the same dog will be declared ineligible and the entry fees forfeited.
- No hand delivered may be accepted for the first 24 hours the trial is open. Entries received opening day must include postage or be metered or be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, DHL. Any entries not meeting the above requirements will be returned.
- For fast acknowledgment of entry, supply an e-mail address.
- **FXED ENTRIES OR MOVE-UPS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
- All entries will be acknowledged after entries close with a judging program.
- Should acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary.

MEASURING

The Judges of Record reserve the right to measure dogs entered in the trial that have not been issued a permanent measurement card. A VMO may or may not be present at this trial.

- In accordance with AKC regulations, all dogs must either have a valid temporary or permanent jump height card, or be measured by a Judge of Record prior to the running of that dog. This measurement will be valid for this weekend only. If a VMO is present all dogs without a permanent jump height card **MUST** be measured.
- **A copy of your jump height cards is NOT REQUIRED TO BE attached to the back of your entry form, nor shown at the site unless requested by the judge of record!**
- All exhibitors and/or handlers are responsible for entering their dog in the proper height division and marking the entry form correctly.
- Dogs shall be moved down to the proper jump height if entered in the incorrect **Preferred** class jump height **only** if measured by Volunteer Measuring Official, AKC Agility Field Representative or Judges of Record.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Michigan requires an official interstate health certificate or official certificate of veterinary inspection. Also a Rabies vaccination by a licensed veterinarian within one year/three years (according to vaccine label directions). Certificate is valid for 30 days from date of examination. Airline certificates are valid for 30 days from date of examination.
- Telephone, telegraphed, fax entries, conditioned entries, and/or photocopied entries without the AKC agreement on the back & **unsigned entries** are not acceptable. **Incomplete or illegible entries are not acceptable** and cannot be entered in the show. (AKC Rule, Chapter 14, Section 4)
- **Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without recipient signature.** If no recipient is present to sign receipt, entries may be returned to sender.
- No entry shall be made and no entry will be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- **Bitches in season will not be allowed in the agility show area of the show grounds. Entry fee (minus \$15) will be refunded for bitches in season with a note from a Veterinarian with their letterhead. Letter must be received at least 24 hours prior to start of judging.**
- No refunds for any other reason after closing.
- Make checks and money orders payable to Ann Arbor Dog Training Club, in U.S. funds. AADTC is not responsible for cash sent in mail. Post-dated or returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a **\$25.00 service fee for returned checks** and all future entries made by the person on that checking account will be put on a CASH ONLY or MONEY ORDER only basis.
- Entries will be acknowledged after entries close with a mailed confirmation and judging program. Ann Arbor Dog Training Club may decline any entries and may remove any dog because of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against AADTC, or any official thereof or any persons assisting with this show.
- Errors on entry forms: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whosoever may make such errors, and no entry shall be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of such entries after the closing date.
- **Please type or print carefully the information on the entry form to eliminate errors.**
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Agility Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance, or other act beyond the control of the Agility Show Committee, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. AADTC will not be responsible, nor is it obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. **Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class.** Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Conflicts will be handled on an individual basis. The judge will not hold up any class judging or wait for any dog which is in conflict with their agility ring time!
- All dogs must be held on leash or confined except when being judged and when in the warm up or exercise area. The safety of dogs is our primary concern. By entering this show, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dog is familiar with & able to perform all obstacles safely. Puppies under the age of 6 months are strictly prohibited from the show site.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner? _____
